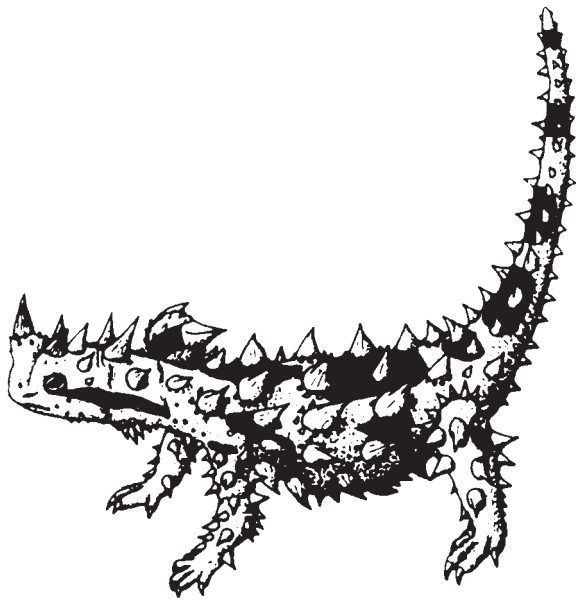

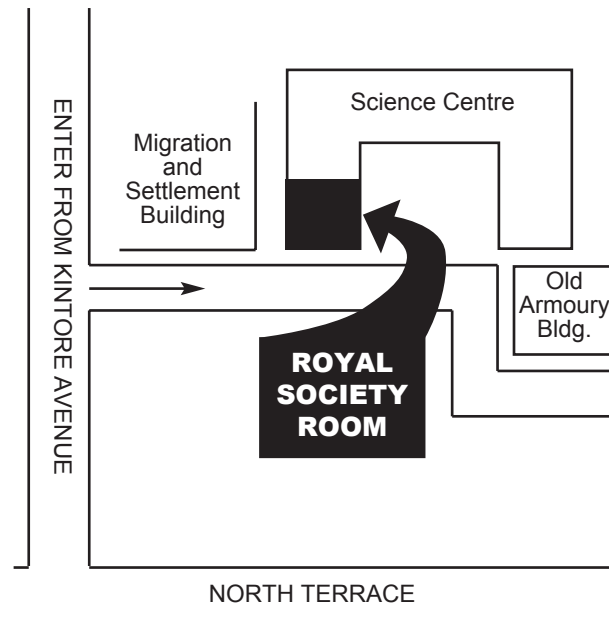


## South Australian Herpetology Group Inc.

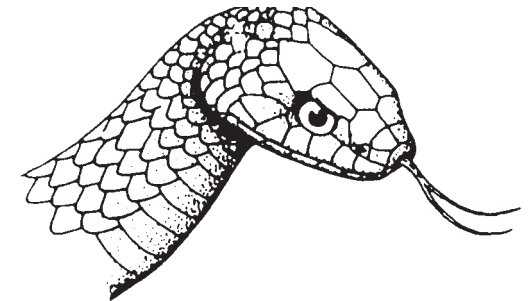

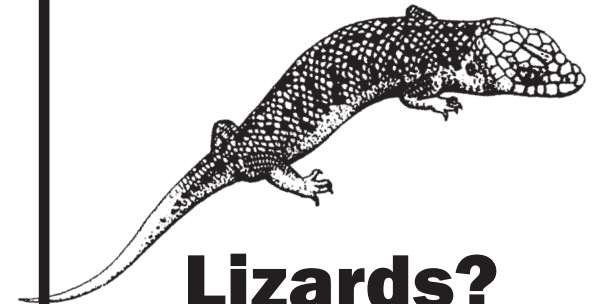

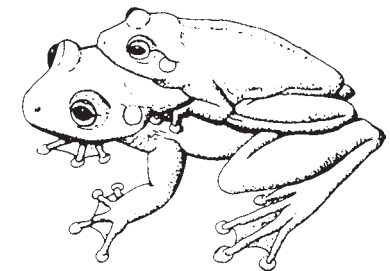
